Information and Rules for the SMILES Open Benefit Horse Show

- Separate entry number required for each horse/rider combination.
- Weekend Hi-Point performance trophy — must show both days.
- Hi-Point awards for each day.
- In case of a tie for High point, highest place in Showmanship wins.
- Classes will have no more than 20 horses working at one time.
- Entries are required by the time the previous class is called.
- 3-minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 minutes will be allowed for a requested tack change.
- Tack change requests are required by the time the previous class is called.
- Once gate is closed, no entry permitted.
- **NO CROSS ENTERING OF AGE BRACKETS**
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO “SMILES”**
- **No Refunds for Scratched Entries**
- Warm up arena available both days!
- Judge’s decision is final.
- Class Entry Fee \$6 each.
- Office Fee \$5 charged for each rider/horse combination.
No office fee charged for Leadline only entries.
- One billing sheet required for each rider/horse combination
- Stalling available \$20 per day per stall. Stall reservations and payment due by July 6.
Mail check to SMILES N2666 County Road K, Darien, WI 53114. Stall reservations not paid by July 6 can not be held and will be on “first come, first serve” basis at the show.
- All proceeds go to benefit SMILES Therapeutic Riding Program.
- Show will take place rain or shine.
- SMILES Food Booth is open and all proceeds will benefit SMILES Therapeutic Riding Program
- Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding— available for sale at the show.
- Fairgrounds charges \$30.00 for camping, with electric. Please pay at registration. First come first serve.
- Not responsible for lost or stolen articles or for damages to or by animals on grounds.
- All stallions must be supervised at all times.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed at the show.
- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times.
