

HORSE TRAILS in the Northern Kettle Moraine State Forest

Provided by the Department of Natural Resources & the Northern Kettle Moraine Horse Trail Association

GENERAL INFO

Horse Trails – 41 miles of trails, open late April thru November. The main linear trail is 33.3 miles long.

Camping – New Prospect Horserider's Campground is centrally located, adjacent to the bridle trail consisting of 20 family sites, 3 group sites, a picnic shelter, drinking water, pit toilets, and a 24 box stall horse shelter. Campers must register prior to set up.

Vehicle Admission Stickers – All vehicles parked in designated use areas must have a state park sticker.

Trail Passes – All horse riders age 16 years or older are required to purchase and carry a valid state trail pass while using designated horse trails.

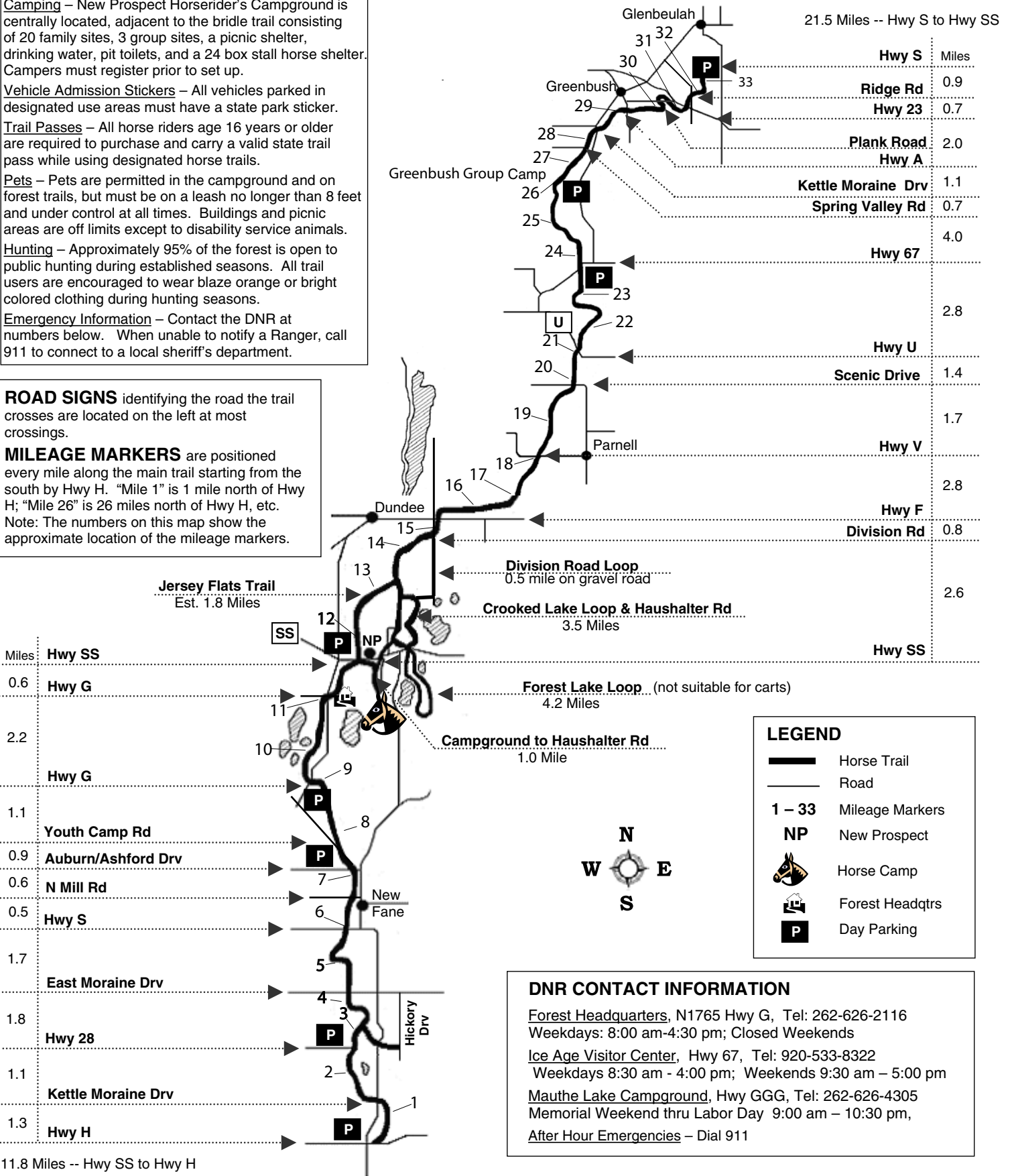
Pets – Pets are permitted in the campground and on forest trails, but must be on a leash no longer than 8 feet and under control at all times. Buildings and picnic areas are off limits except to disability service animals.

Hunting – Approximately 95% of the forest is open to public hunting during established seasons. All trail users are encouraged to wear blaze orange or bright colored clothing during hunting seasons.

Emergency Information – Contact the DNR at numbers below. When unable to notify a Ranger, call 911 to connect to a local sheriff's department.

ROAD SIGNS identifying the road the trail crosses are located on the left at most crossings.

MILEAGE MARKERS are positioned every mile along the main trail starting from the south by Hwy H. "Mile 1" is 1 mile north of Hwy H; "Mile 26" is 26 miles north of Hwy H, etc. Note: The numbers on this map show the approximate location of the mileage markers.

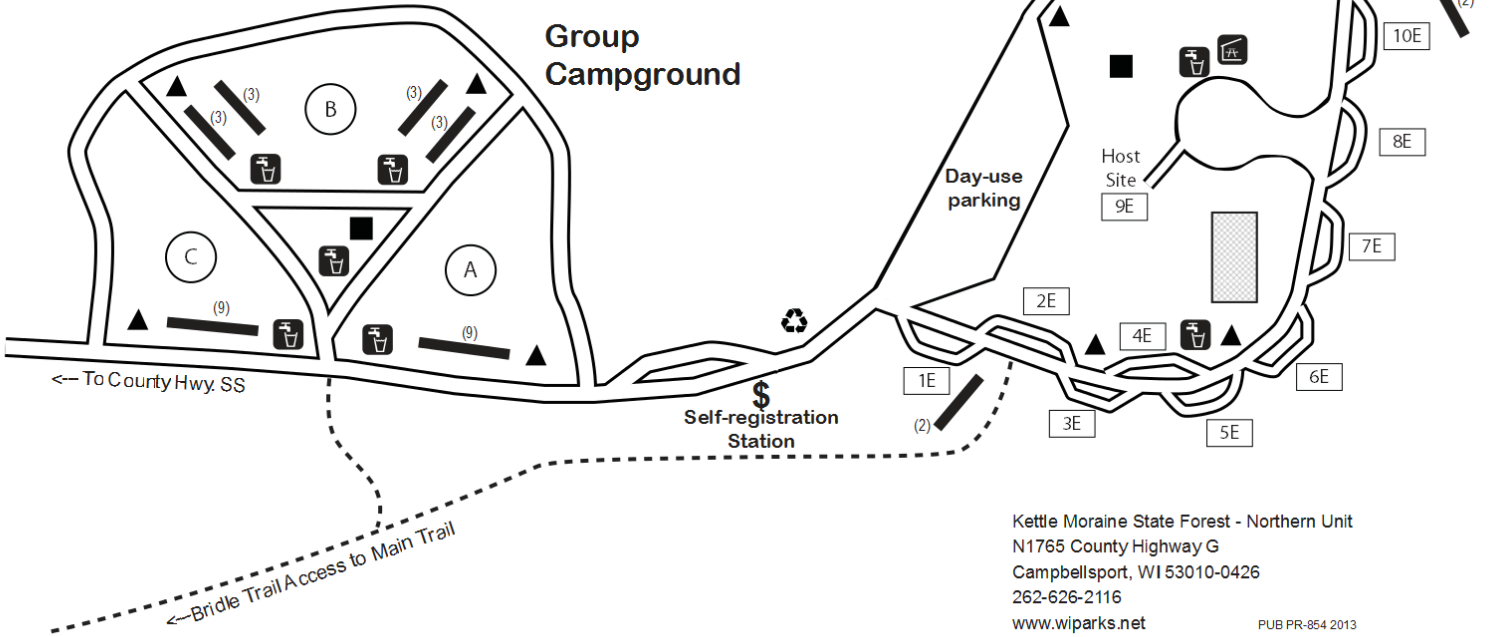
