- Tack changes must be requested at least 2 classes before

- ◇ Classes 6–38 count towards High Point (excluding Novice, Discipline Rail, Hunter Hack & 4-H Member classes)
- ◇ Age Division Highpoint Awards at each show
- ◇ Horse & Rider combo must use the same back number for all three shows to be considered for series high points
- ◇ Overall Series Age Division Highpoint Awards (total points after series, must have 20 pts or more)
- ◇ Overall Series Highpoint Awards: Halter, Western Horse & English Horse (total points after series)
- ◇ English includes Huntseat, Saddleseat, etc.
- ◇ Novice—Horse & Rider combination has not won 2 blue ribbons in that class prior to show
- ◇ Original and Copy of current coggins (EIA) required for all horses on the grounds (must be dated within 1 year of show)
- ◇ All exhibitors must wear boots and an SEI approved helmet. No sleeveless shirts allowed while riding.
- ◇ All dogs must be on a leash
- ◇ No studs/uncut males allowed
- ◇ Absolutely NO smoking in or around the barns
- ◇ Exhibitors MUST be at least 3rd grade or above
- ◇ Alcohol is NOT permitted on the grounds
- ◇ Food stand on grounds—Open until 2pm or bring your own lunch
